All information REQUIRED BELOW must be provided by you for your project request to be timely reviewed by the ARC.

1. Photograph of both the front and back of your home—including "line of sight" from the golf course if your home backs to the golf course.
2. Photograph of, or a small sample of your roof color **AND** a photograph of your house with view of neighbors' homes on each side.
3. The manufacturer name and the color name **AND** the color number for **each paint color and** area to be painted. i.e. color names for the body, trim, shutters and doors, etc.
4. Sample of paint colors to be used. You **must submit** the actual paint color sample to the office. *Samples should be no more than 5x7 inch or less in size. The manufacturer small "chip" sample is preferred.* (neutral and earth tones are required when applicable) If you are painting siding then paint sample of the color should be done on a piece of wood siding, vinyl or other material with a neutral or white background (do not paint on colored paper or cardboard as this will not provide a true color sample). Deliver the sample or manufacturer chip to the office along with your request. **Photographs or email of paint colors are NOT acceptable.**
5. IF YOU ARE RE-PAINTING or RE-STAINING USING THE SAME COLOR THE ARC DOES NOT NEED TO APPROVE. If you have any doubt, then submit a form request for approval.
